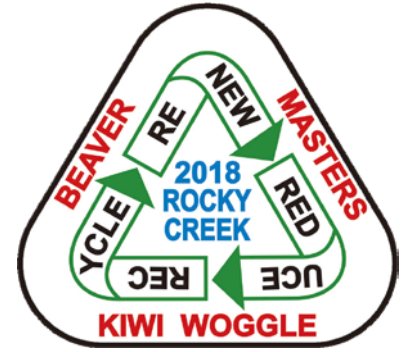




# Kiwi Woggle Local Rules

## "RECYCLING"



Patrols from all areas are invited to compete for the Kiwi Woggle (1st Place) and the Kiwi trophy (2nd place). The current Host District will hold the Kiwi Woggle and the Kiwi Trophy for good keeping until the next Kiwi Woggle, when the current winners will be invited to hand over to the next Host District for presentation. Inexperienced patrols may participate with assistance by sub camp leaders.

## Camp Rules and Regulations

- Camp Code:** The Scout Law, Scout Promise and Scout Safe.
- Check-in:** On arrival from 8am. Please follow parking marshal's directions.  
Patrol Check in is adjacent to main parade ground .
- Registration** The Patrol Leader will check-in their patrol with:  
3 x **copies** of their C4s with all activities signed  
1 x Campfire Skit description to be handed in.
- The PL will keep a copy of C4's to be with him always  
The other two copies go to Admin to be distributed.
  - C4's must be current with **Low Ropes, Archery, Abseiling, Pioneering, Canoeing, Swimming, and Mountain Biking**, signed off by parents.
  - Any changes to Patrol membership must be provided
  - Patrols must be registered with all details provided
  - Participants must be financial members of the association
- Identification:** All scouts and venturers will wear provided lanyards for the entire camp.

**Cost:** \$50.00 per scout. This is only for the camping fees and activities – Food is to be provided by each patrol.  
Patrol members names must be submitted with the nomination fee by registration closing date. Any changes to the patrol member's names must be advised at the administration centre on arrival and new paper work submitted.

\*\*\*\*Please note – 1 bag of ice will be supplied to each patrol on Saturday and Sunday at their cost. Additional ice can be ordered via the registration form\*\*\*\*

Leaders / Adults cost are \$25 camping fee and \$45 catering fee.

**Refund:** There is no refund for non-attendance or early departure unless there is extenuating circumstances.

If Camp is cancelled after closing date there will be a 10% charge on refunds. The Camp Chief will make the final decision.

**Leader Registration:**

All Leaders, adults, rovers and Venturers are required to register via registration form and pay fees by due date. Check in at registration point on arrival. All leaders/adults must hold a valid blue card and be a financial member of Scouts QLD.

**Parking:** Parking will be available in designated areas. Troops will be given designated space to drop off trailers. Trailers will be towed to sub Camps by staff for Patrols. Parents will be directed to a drop off area for youth members and their gear. (no cars to be driven to sub camps other than Sub camp leaders cars) Adults may have cars at leader camping area but they must not be moved all weekend. If the cars are to be moved they must be parked in designated area.

**Animals & Pets:** No dogs, cats or other animals are allowed

**Restricted Areas:** Caretakers house and yard, Machinery sheds are out of bounds.

**Security:** All members must follow the directions of security staff

**Judging:** Judging will be based on the Camping Standards guidelines found on Scouts Qld Website or Kiwi Woggle website and will take place Saturday and Sunday. All construction must finish by 8am Saturday. QP (Queenslander Patrol) tents and Dome tents may be used.

**Campsite:** Patrols must keep their campsites clean and tidy at all times.

**Patrol Administration:**

A copy of a list of members, C4s, menu, duty roster, and any other relevant paperwork must be on view at your campsite at all times.

**Construction:** No pre-assembly of camp gateway or site gadgets is allowed. Any preassembled items will need to be disassembled and started again on site.

**Patrol Flag:** Each Patrol is to design a Patrol flag to incorporate your patrol name. This flag is to be flown at your campsite and will be judged during the weekend.

**Gateway:** Each patrol shall construct a themed gateway for their campsite, It is to be constructed out of the material of the name of your allotted sub camp (ie: plastic sub camp, gateway to be plastic).

An award will be given for the one judged best on site. All scout safe policies are to be adhered to. Please ensure structures are within height limitations. Maintenance is allowed and any requests or suggestions made by the Judges should also be followed through by the Patrols.

**Sub camps:** Patrols will be allocated to sub camps with a sub camp Leader in charge. Patrols will be notified 1<sup>st</sup> week of March of Sub Camp Allocations.

**Camp Security:** Leaders must advise and sign in with Sub Camp Leaders when entering Sub Camps.

Camp supervision is the role of the Sub Camp Leaders and any difficulties/problems should be rectified with the assistance of the Sub Camp Leader.

Visiting Scout members, Parents or Laypersons wishing to visit youth members must sign in at Administration/Security on arrival.

**Leader Assistance:**

Leaders are requested **not** to assist any patrol in any way during the competition. Should a problem be noticed, it should immediately be reported to the Camp Chief and/or Sub-Camp Leader who will ensure these patrols receive any necessary assistance immediately.

Details of inexperienced Patrols should be advised when registering and assistance and guidance will be provided when necessary.

**Leaders & Rovers:**

Leaders/Adults will camp separately to youth. All leaders will be allocated jobs. Leaders may pre-order meals via their registration form (**BYO own mess kit**) or self-cater.

**Venturers:** There will be a Venturer sub-camp with a Sub-Camp Leaders. All Venturers will be allocated Jobs Venturers may pre-order meals (**BYO own mess kit**) or self-cater.  
**Venturer numbers capped at 25.**

**Opening Parade:** Will be at 9am **Good Friday** Full uniform.

**Patrol Leaders meeting** adjacent to Administration **straight after parade.**

**Leaders meeting** will be at **11am** on Good Friday. Venturers and Rovers should attend the Leaders' Meeting. Lunch on Friday (at no cost) will be supplied for all Leaders, Venturers and Rovers.

**Saturday and Sunday Parade:**

All patrols must attend parade each morning at their sub camp.

**Cooking:** Gas or open fire cooking. (Fire wood can be collected onsite)

**Water:** The campsite is on town water, all taps on site are town water.  
Showers will be timed. Please conserve water.

**Garbage:** Garbage will be required to be taken to a collection point at each sub camp. Rubbish will be collected each morning. All campsites must have **enclosed** (with a lid) garbage collection bins, this is to stop the wildlife from invading your rubbish.

**First Aid:** First Aid will be available adjacent to Administration.  
All accidents/injuries must be reported to Administration and or Camp Chief immediately. If an emergency, call 000 then advise Camp Chief or Administration. All first aid given must be documented. Incident Reports will be available at Administration. Any first aid issues at the camp site should be reported to the Sub-Camp Leader or Activity Leader.

**Child Safe Scouting Officer:**  
Will be responsible for all areas of Scouts Child protection policy.  
Any Non-Compliance or incidents relating to the child protection policy must be reported to this officer.

**Departure:** Your campsite will be required to be left in a tidy condition and loading of gear will be in reverse of arriving. Following direction of Security officials.

**Activities:** Some of the Saturday and Sunday activities will be Water Activities, Low ropes, and Campfire skit audition. Other activities may include: Archery, Mountain Biking, Geo-caching, Scout skills and many more fun activities.

### **Things Patrols need to know and do:**

**Backpack:** Each Scout is required to carry a day backpack large enough to hold: large water bottle, extra sunscreen, insect repellent, personal medication ie. Asthma Puffers, Epi-pens and personal first aid kit. Patrol leader must carry a copy of Patrols C4's.

### **Camp / Activity Dress standard**

- Broad brimmed hat
- Closed in Shoes
- Sleeved and collared shirts (short or long) NO SLEEVELESS TOPS.
- NO bare midriffs
- Long shorts or trousers. NO 'SHORT' SHORTS.
- Anyone dressed inappropriately will be sent back to camp to change and take the chance of not going to the activity.

### **Sun Safety:**

- Broad brimmed hats are required at all times. Patrol points will be lost if without hats. NO CAPS. This applies to adults too.
- Sunscreen. Apply sunscreen before leaving camp each morning. Again after water activities or At Lunch time.
- Shirts must have at least short sleeves (no sleeveless tops)

### **Dehydration:**

- Carry your water bottle to all activities – onsite.
- Top up bottle at camp, before going to activities. All taps are drinkable water.

### **Water Activities:**

- Broad brimmed hat that can get wet
- Long Board shorts (swimmers can be worn underneath)
- Rash shirt
- Old lace up shoes that can get wet. NO CROCS
- Water Bottle
- Small towel

**Camp Catering:** Please choose foods that will keep unchilled and can be carried in your backpacks.

Hygiene practices must be kept to a high standard

### **Leader Dinner – Saturday:**

When preparing your menu allow for an additional meal for a leader who you will invite **with an invitation** to dine with your patrol on Saturday evening this leader must be from outside your district preferred. This leader will be judging your menu, meal preparation, presentation, quality, grace and clean-up. Two course meal of your choice.

### **Kiwi Woggle Badge:**

Each paying participant - youth or adult will receive a badge.

**Campfire skit:** There will be a campfire on Sunday evening. During Friday and Saturday your patrol will be required to perform the skit/song to be selected to perform at the Campfire by the Skit Judges.

Please be prepared with your props for your audition. PLs will be advised when audition for your patrol will take place.

### **Toilets and Showers:**

There is to be no playing in toilets or loitering.

Patrols will be given an allotted shower time, Sub camp leaders are to supervise youth at the toilet blocks at shower time.
